

Would you like to broaden your ability in jazz improvisation?
Would you like to learn how to improvise on your instrument and create your own music?

If you have answered "Yes" to these questions, you might like to consider learning jazz improvisation on a Saturday morning from 10.30 am – 12:30 pm at the Australian Jazz Museum, 15 Mountain Hwy, Wantirna VIC 3152.

Students receive a high level of tuition and guidance from two of Melbourne's expert music educationalists: Viv Doolan (brass, woodwind and rhythm) and Brian Abrahams (drums and percussion).

The workshop is a 12 week immersion course in Jazz Improvisation. The Course focuses on developing the students' knowledge of chords, transposition, chord progressions, aural training, general knowledge of the jazz genre, difference in styles, and performance skills.

It is expected that students can play their instrument to a reasonable standard of proficiency (the equivalent of Grade 5 AMEB). It is also expected that students arrive at least 15 minutes before 10.30 am to warm up and prepare for the class.

This workshop in conducted in collaboration with the Australian Jazz Museum, and participants are expected to be members of the Museum. The workshops will start on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2023, and run for 12 weeks. The cost of the course is \$200 plus Museum membership fees.
